# 1. Organizational Change

# (1) Purpose of Organizational Change

In order to respond to diversifying market needs, UT Group's organization will be restructured into four business divisions, further strengthening client contact points, and realizing independent management in each business. This transforms us into an organization that makes faster decisions and maximizes its value proposition. With regard to the head office function, we will build a structure to strengthen the function of providing services to job seekers as well as to our technical employees and client companies.


# (2) Outline of Organizational Change

[Motor Vehicle/Energy Business Division]

The Motor Vehicle/Energy Business Division will provide just-in-time labor supply as a service to major clients and related companies in the automotive and automotive parts industry and battery-related industries. The division will also be in charge of UT SURI-EMU, which is engaged in the Nikkei (Japanese-origin foreign) worker business for the same industries.

#### [Semiconductors Strategic Business Division]

The Semiconductors Strategic Business Division will be organized to establish the structure for job development and career development and to improve unit prices of transactions with major clients and related companies in the semiconductor industry. The division will also be in charge of UT Toshiba, which has a similar business model.







#### [Agent Business Division]

To advance the Area Strategy and provide recruitment services with a high matching rate that is to be appreciated by job seekers, the Agent Business Division will be organized to expand the personnel placement business beyond the worker dispatch business.

# [Next Career Strategy Division]


